WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school Freshmen and Sophomores who have a strong interest in science and or a health care profession. • Arizona residents. • All students must be US citizens or permanent residents. • Tox-Start welcomes applications from all students.
HOW DOES A STUDENT APPLY?	<p><u>Applications are due May 10, 2006</u></p> <p>Students must submit the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A completed and signed Tox-Start application form. 2. A current high school transcript (ask your counselor for assistance). 3. Two completed recommendation forms. <p>Please mail all materials together in one envelope. We must receive all application materials by May 10, 2006 in order for the application to be reviewed by the selection committees. Incomplete applications will not be considered.</p>
WHAT WILL I DO IN THE PROGRAM?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please note that Tox-Start is an academic enrichment program. Students are expected to attend all academic classes and complete all homework assignments. • Students will have an opportunity to explore basic toxicology principles in laboratory activities, visit research laboratories and research an environmental health topic. • Activities include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ explore basic toxicology principals in laboratory experiments ▪ learn about local environmental health topics ▪ meet with students and faculty ▪ tour biomedical laboratories ▪ research an environmental health topic
